## ENTRY

- £15 (£10 juniors\*), if Silver or higher ECF membership
- £25 (£20 juniors\*), if Bronze ECF member or not a member
- Enter online (preferred) by 08/01/2022, or post entry form with cheque by 03/01/2022.
- Entry at the door will incur an additional fee of £10.
- Requests for refunds of online payments accepted up to 29/12/2020 (refund will be amount paid minus transaction fee)  
\*Junior < 18 years on the day

2020 tournament had 79 players, but we have space for many more!!

## FORMAT

### **5 rounds Swiss with three sections (all FIDE and ECF rated):**

1. Open (with top 3 boards played on boards broadcasted on the internet)
2. U1900, open to any player whose FIDE and ECF rapid ratings are both below 1900.
3. U1600, open to any player whose FIDE and ECF rapid ratings are both below 1600.

Where player has no FIDE rapid rating, FIDE standard rating applies. If player has both, highest rating will be used for ranking.

ECF rapid rating minimum 10 games, otherwise most recent standard rating. If player has both, highest rating will be used for ranking.

Player can request to play in a higher section. The organiser reserves the right to move players between sections.

**Time control: 20 mins + 10 seconds increment from move 1.**

- Venue was used for the British 2021 Championships, British Womens 2021 Championships and the Hull 4NCL International Congress 2021

## PRIZES

### Per section:

- 1<sup>st</sup> place £120, 2<sup>nd</sup> place £60, 3<sup>rd</sup> place £30
- 1<sup>st</sup> performance prize: £30, 2<sup>nd</sup> performance prize: £20

All place prize money will be shared equally between tied players.

Performance prizes for the highest performance score, amongst players who haven't won a place prize.

No player may win more than one money prize.

A Junior Trophy is awarded to the junior who scores highest number of points in any section.

Spot prizes for best performance in first 4 rounds.

We reserve the right to alter any and all prize money if entries fall below the expected level.
